# **CSO OUTFALL PROTECTION PROJECT**

## **DESCRIPTION**

The CSO Outfall Protection (CSO-OP) project will fortify a Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) outfall from accelerated shoreline erosion along Lake Erie.

As shown on the map, the CSO Outfall Protection project is located near the Beulah Park neighborhood adjacent to East 156th Street and Evergreen Place.

#### **PROJECT WORK**

Recent high lake levels and storm events have resulted in shoreline erosion near NEORSD CSO outfall 207. To protect the outfall infrastructure from damage, the CSO-OP project will construct an armor stone revetment similar to the emergency repair completed at CSO-206 in Spring 2020, shown in the figure below.

## POTENTIAL COMMUNITY IMPACTS

During construction, the CSO-OP project will have some short-term impacts on the community, including:

- Sidewalk closures;
- Noise and vibrations; and
- Dust, dirt, and/or mud
