


DESCRIPTION

The CSO-249/McCracken/East 112th Sewer Improvements project is located in Garfield Heights near McCracken Road and Turney Road. The project will include private lateral dye-testing to confirm the locations of sanitary connections and reconnection of laterals as needed, sewer separation work, sewer rehabilitation and making interconnections between pipes as needed. Once the project is complete the District's Combined Sewer Overflow CSO-249, which overflows approximately 57 times and 9.6 MG in a typical year, will be eliminated as a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permitted outfall. Additionally, the project improvements will provide residents with a reduced basement flooding risk going from a low level of service (1-year) to a 10-year level of service in this area.
