

## Summary

The District partnered with the Cuyahoga County Soil and Water Conservation District by providing matching funds for this Ohio EPA Section 319 grant-funded project to enhance instream and riparian functionality and habitat. This project is in the City of Willoughby Hills on a segment of Euclid Creek that is not in the Service Area but is part of the Regional Stormwater. The project involved the restoration and floodplain enhancement along ~800 linear feet of the East Branch of Euclid Creek. In addition, the project design took advantage of opportunities to create passive stormwater management enhancements to capture runoff from the adjacent school parking lot.
