Summary


The District partnered with the West Creek Conservancy by providing matching funds and inkind services for this Ohio EPA Section 319 grant-funded project. This project involved the restoration of 2,500 linear feet of stream channel and floodplain area and daylighting nearly 75 linear feet of piped tributary. Existing gabion baskets were removed and eroding stream banks were restored through the use of bioengineered bank stabilization techniques. The removal of a concrete ford allowed for better channel alignment and enhanced fish passage and habitat. Native riparian vegetation was planted to improve riparian/floodplain habitat.
