Summary

The District has partnered with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) to develop a Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI) project to address fish passage at the Euclid Creek E 185th Street Spillway. The recommended approach is to construct a more gradual, natural rock ramp up to the top of the spillway to reestablish fish passage without demolishing the existing structure. The District is responsible for obtaining the ne easements and/or rights-of-way necessary to construct and maintain the project. The USACE is responsible for design and construction of a fish ladder, which is funded by the USEPA through the GLRI. The construction is anticipated to commence in Spring 2025.

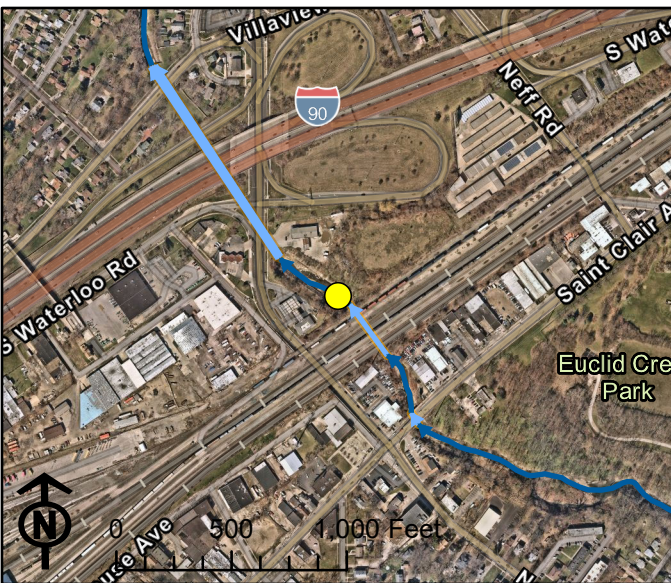
