Summary

The District partnered with the West Creek Conservancy by providing matching funds and in-kind services for this Ohio EPA Section 319 grant-funded project. This project involved the restoration and revegetation of ~500+ linear feet of an unnamed headwater stream and associated floodplain (approximately 3 acres) to the West Creek in Parma, Ohio. The project also involve the creation of 1.37 acres of wetlands along the stream corridor. The project restored bank stability and floodplain function of a previously re-routed stream segment in the context of an active, urban park.

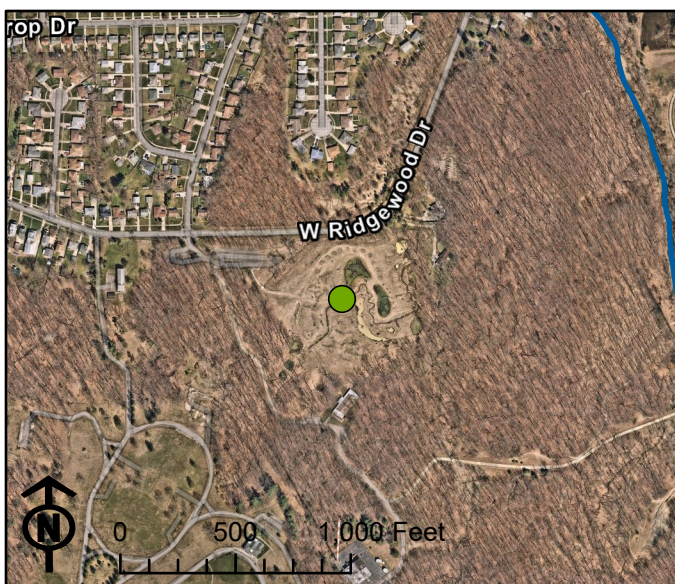
