

POLO FIELD STREAM RESTORATION

Moreland Hills, OH

CHAGRIN RIVER · SMALL TRIBS TO CHAGRIN RIVER

Summary

The District is partnering with the Cleveland Metroparks by providing financial support for this stream restoration project, located in the South Chagrin Reservation. A concrete culvert impedes stormwater conveyance resulting in the inundation of the surrounding polo fields and service road. This culvert also creates a fish barrier and contributes to eroding slopes and bank instability. This project replaces the existing culvert crossing with a pedestrian bridge improving stormwater conveyance and restoring fish/invertebrate passage and habitat. Bio-engineered bank stabilization techniques will be used to restore ~200 linear feet of stream banks. The restoration of this stream asset will build on earlier upstream stabilization efforts.

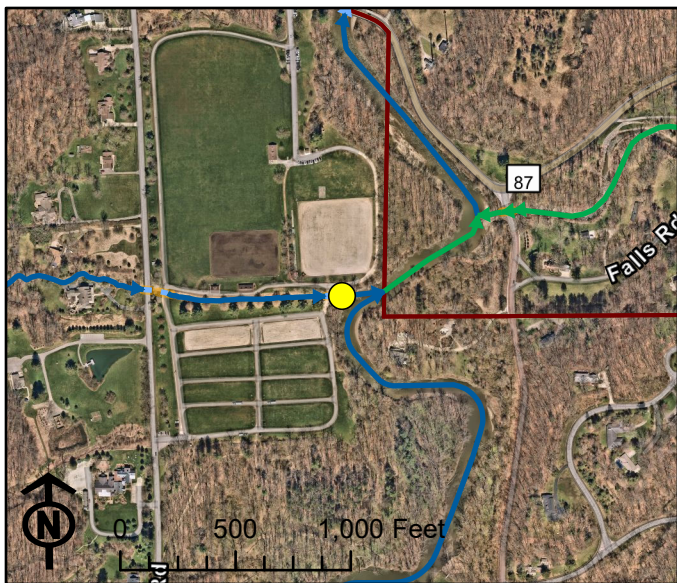
