As an account holder with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (Sewer District), you are currently being assessed a stormwater fee as part of the Sewer District's Regional Stormwater Management Program. Through a credit application previously approved by the Sewer District, you verified there are one or more stormwater control measures (SCMs) on your property that effectively manage stormwater to reduce impacts on the regional stormwater system. You are currently receiving a credit, which provides for a reduction towards your property's stormwater fee.

 - o <u>Individual Permit</u> coverage provide your current 12-month period Annual Report per *Monitoring & Reporting Requirements* in Parts IV, V & VI;
 - o No Exposure Certification provide your Ohio EPA acknowledgement letter for the current 5-year period.
- To renew any type of "Water Quality Agricultural" credit, check both self-certification boxes found below Box 10.
- For all other types of "Water Quantity" and "Water Quality" credits, provide an annual inspection report that summarizes the current condition of each SCM, including recent photos, completed by you or your representative.

Alternatively, you may choose to renew your credit(s) through the Sewer District's on-line renewal tool. Go to www.neorsd.org, select the "Stormwater" drop down arrow, select "Apply for a Stormwater Fee Credit", and select "Stormwater Application Renewal" to begin the application process.

Please note that recertification documentation must be received by July 20, 2021. Failure to provide the required information will result in the expiration of all applicable credits. Thank you for your contribution toward the management of stormwater to reduce the impacts on the regional stormwater system. 





