Summary:

The Bay Point project involves the preservation of a 65 acres tract, which includes 12,500 linear feet of shoreline and 34.1 acres of high-quality coastal wetlands. The Bay Point property consists of a narrow peninsula that extends south from Catawba Island into Sandusky Bay. The peninsula is located within the historical Great Black Swamp?? the coastal wetlands within the Property are some of the last remaining wetlands from this swamp. Several endangered or threatened plant species, and 77 bird species, including several warbler species have been viewed on the Property. In addition to aiding in water quality attainment and permanently protecting this tract of land, protection of the Property provides historic, social, and aesthetic value.


