## Beaver Creek-Bass Lake Connector

### Summary:

The Beaver Creek/Bass Lake Connector project involved the preservation of a 133-acre tract, including 106.71 acres of upland buffer, through tract acquisition. This project will conserve 1,917 linear feet of Beaver Creek, 1,770 linear feet of a Class 3 headwater stream and 6,555 linear feet of intermittent and ephemeral streams. This tract contains 26.6 acres of Category 3 emergent, shrub, and forested wetlands, providing habitat to 181 plant species. The acquisition and protection of this tract creates corridor of over 1,218 acres of preserved land, which includes the 300-acre Bass Lake II tract owned by Cleveland Museum of Natural History, 606-acre Bass Lake Preserve and the 129-acre Beaver Creek Preserve owned by Geauga Park District.
