Summary:

The Bronson Creek preservation project involved the acquisition of 361 acres of natural area within the Grand River watershed. The project resulted in the preservation of 9,754 linear feet of stream and the protection of 336.84-acres of Category 3 wetlands dominated by high-quality groundwater forested wetlands and forested mosaic wetlands which surround the deeper marsh wetlands. Acquisition of this Property will continue to protect environmental function and habitat diversity in the area, as well as provide water quality and environmental benefits to the downstream waters of Spring Creek, Trumbull Creek, Grand River, and ultimately Lake Erie.
