Summary:

The Daly Fallon Fen preservation project consisted of the acquisition of an ~52-acre tract, which is surrounded on three sides by the Holden Arboretum. This tract is comprised of nearly continuous forest and includes 4.5-acres of Category 3 alkaline wetland which supports several rare plant species including Showy lady's slippers, Downy Willowherb and Water Avens. Acquisition of this tract also allows for the preservation of 5,110 linear feet of the East Branch of the Chagrin River, Stebbins Run and two other un-named primary headwater streams. The goal in acquiring this tract is to maintain the ecological integrity and function of the Daly Fallen Fen in its entirety and increase the size of the surrounding forested buffer area.


