Summary:

This project involved the removal of one dam that had degraded habitat and served as barrier to fish passage in Baldwin Creek. This project also restored ~400 linear feet of stream. The main goals of this project included restoration of fish passage, improve fish in-stream habitat, reduce channel and bank erosion, and improved water quality. This project improves the capability for Euclid Creek to reach full attainment as a Warm Water Habitat.
