Summary:

The Farmington Forested Wetland Expansion project consists of the acquisition and restoration of a 181-acre tract, which includes 55.6 acres of Category 3 forested, shrub and emergent marsh wetlands and 1,029 linear feet of Class III cold water Swine Creek tributary. The wetlands associated with this site are essential to the water quality of the Upper Grand River watershed. This project will restore an additional 12.4 acres of Category 3 wetlands, as well as 1,000 linear feet of unnamed stream. This tract's wetland is home to river otters along with 277 plant species, 48 bird species, and 4 types of frogs. This project will preserve the water quality, river morphology, and aquatic habitat in this section of the Grand River watershed.
