Summary:

This project resulted in the purchase and preservation an ~91-acre tract (“Medina Marsh”) containing 32 acres of Category 3 wetlands and 2,725 linear feet of unnamed tributaries to the West Branch of the Rocky River. The wetland habitat includes lowland woods, marsh, and scrub/shrub communities. The property’s western boundary is less than 50 feet from the West Branch of the Rocky River, and the tract’s floodplain forest increases the forested buffer along 1,450 linear feet of the West Branch of the Rocky River. This is a valuable long-term water resource protection project that will serve to maintain and improve water quality in the West Branch of the Rocky River subwatershed and the larger Rocky River watershed.

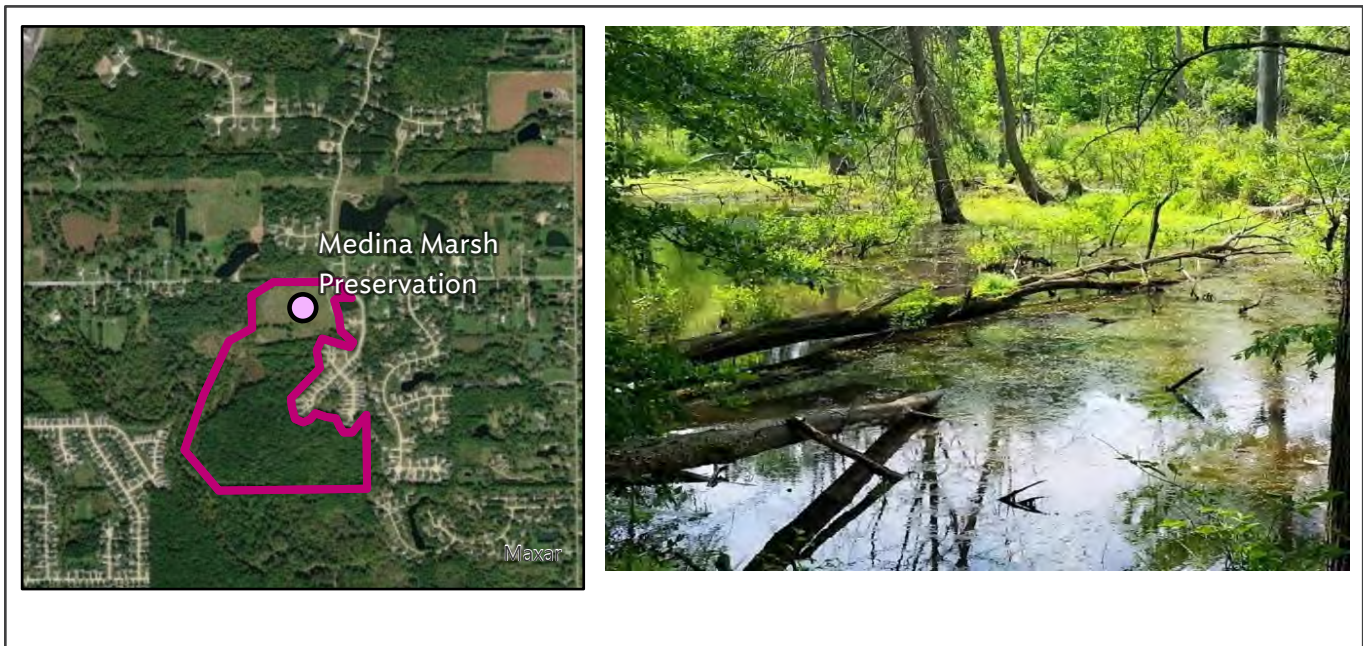
