Summary:

The Springfield Bog Expansion involved the acquisition of a 41.07-acre tract, which included 30.58 acres of Category 3 emergent, shrub and forested bog, along with 10-acres of upland second growth woods and shrub habitat. This expansion will be an addition onto the adjoining 250+-acre Summit Metro Parks Springfield Bog Metro Park. Site surveys have confirmed the presence of three rare Ohio-listed plants including the Swamp birch, Sharp-glumed mannagrass and Bebb's sedge. This project will preserve the water quality, wetland morphology, and habitat diversify in this section of the little Cuyahoga River watershed.
