Summary:

The Sulphur Springs Headwaters Phase III project preserves a key 30-acre forested wetland/upland complex in an urbanized area of the Chagrin River watershed. This acquired property is adjacent to a network of approximately 3,814 acres of protected land, owned by the city of Solon and Cleveland Metroparks. The property sits at the upper most reaches of the Sulphur Springs subwatershed is significant as it is an important groundwater resource that contributes to the base flow of the South Branch of Sulphur Springs. The South Branch of Sulphur Springs, a high quality, coldwater tributary of the State Scenic Chagrin River, is targeted for the reintroduction of native brook trout.

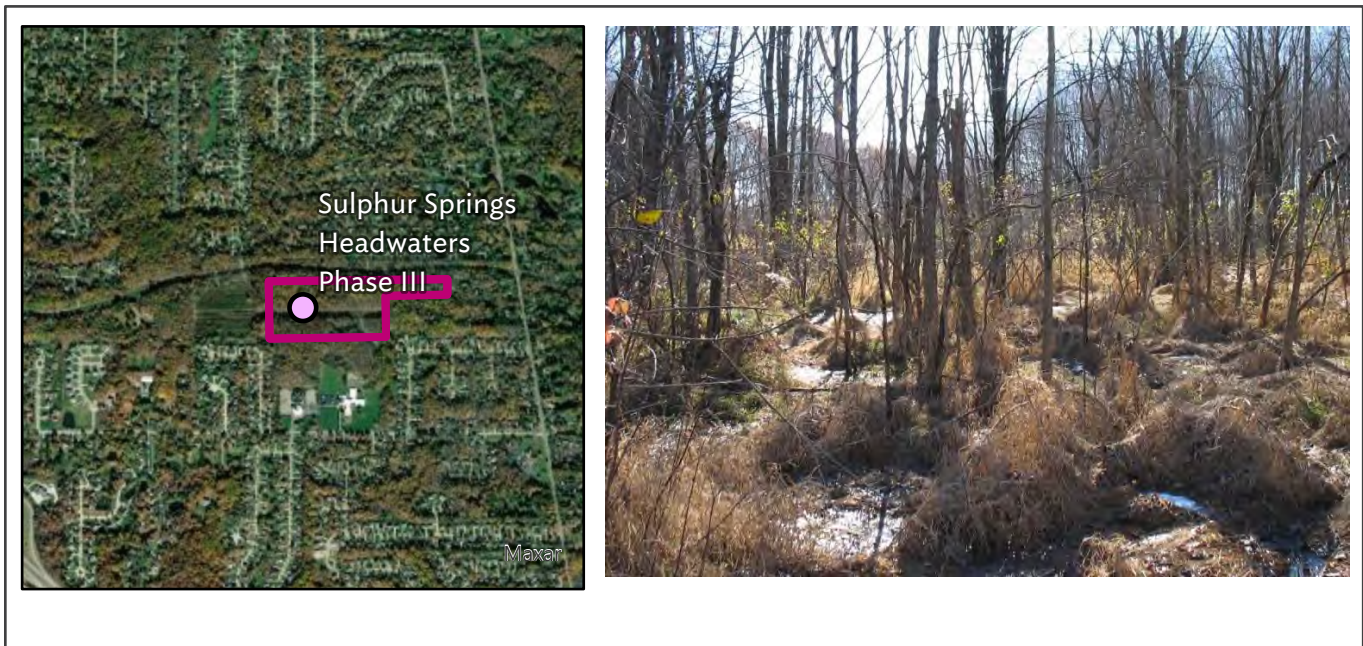
