Summary:

This project involved the purchase and permanent conservation of the Twinsburg Bog II tract. This conservation project preserves 43 acres hosting Category 3 wetlands, frontage along 1,430 linear feet of the main stem of Tinker’s Creek, and floodplain habitat for a variety of rare plant species. The project site is significant because of its relatively undisturbed complex of emergent, scrub/shrub, and forested wetlands. The project permanently protects biologically significant habitat suitable for seven State-listed species including Showy Lady’s-slipper and Swamp-oats. This is a valuable long-term water resource protection project that serves to maintain and improve water quality in Tinker’s Creek and the larger Cuyahoga River watersheds.
