Summary:

The Wahoo wetlands preservation project involved the acquisition of 110 acres of natural area within the Middle Cuyahoga River watershed. The project has resulted in the preservation of 50-acres dominated by sand barrens, and tall shrub bog/fen Category 3 wetlands. In addition, this project protects approximately 2,735 linear feet of Breakneck Creek and one of its tributary streams. Acquisition of this Property will continue to protect environmental function and habitat diversity in the area, as well as provide water quality and environmental benefits to the downstream waters of Breakneck Creek, Cuyahoga River, and ultimately Lake Erie.

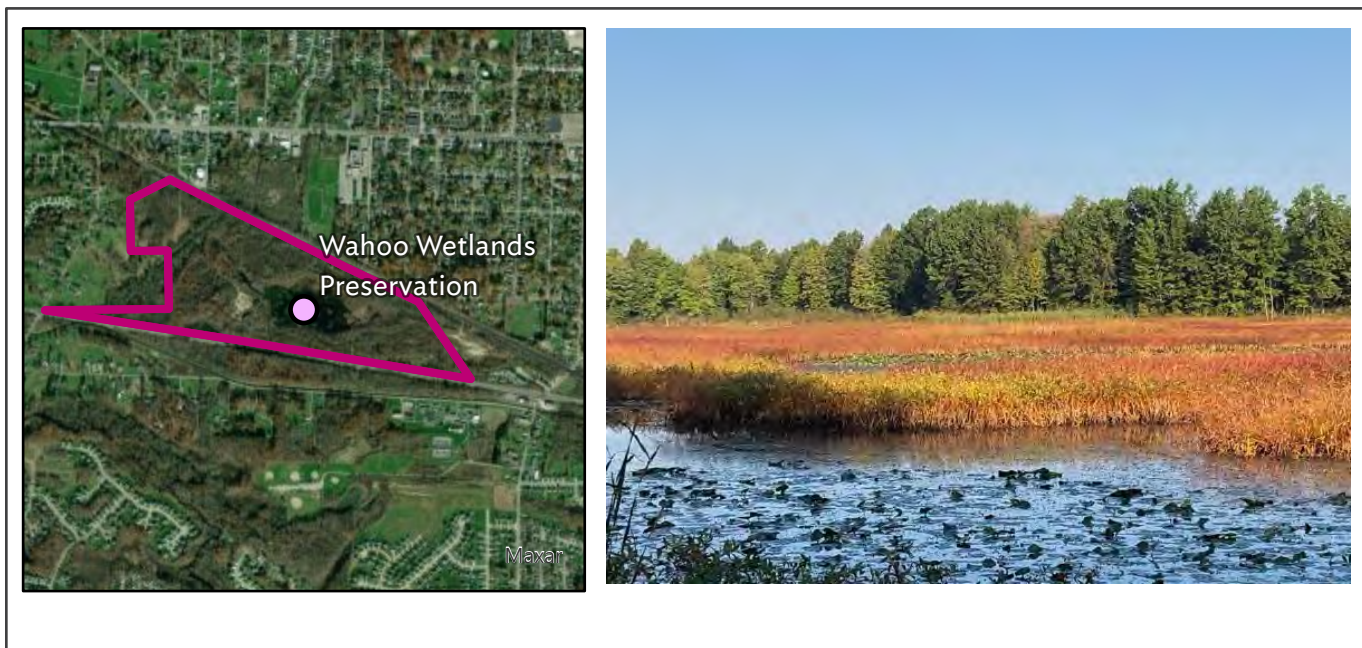
