## **Summary:**

Over the past two decades significant improvements have been made to water quality and biological health of the Mahoning River, part of which has been the removal of 5 dams along various reaches of the River through the WRRSP program. This project involves the removal of a sixth dam, which will bring an additional 9.53 miles of the Mahoning River into Warmwater Habitat attainment. As part of this project, ~5,000 cubic yards of sediment will be removed behind the dam and a total of 1,200 linear feet of stream bank will be restored and stabilized. The goal of this project is to further improve the water quality, river morphology, aquatic habitat and fish passage in this section of the Mahoning River.
