Summary:

The West Creek stream restoration project involved the restoration of 2,475 linear feet of stream and floodplain bench. Restoration activities included the removal of concrete debris, the excavation and enhancement of floodplain benches, daylighting portions of the discharging culverts and the creation of in-stream habitat. Restoration of these stream segments will improve the hydraulic and flow characteristics of the channel, improve invertebrate/fish habitat and migration in the stream channel while improving the diversification of riparian plant species.


